We are called to address hunger & poverty by providing food, clothing, & household items through regular gifts to the local Food Bank, adopting families at Christmas, serving food at warming shelters, & providing seedlings for people to start gardens. We contribute to local programs that support the local schools & are committed to expanding our relationship with the schools to help provide for young people in need. We desire to be a growing congregation of people who expand our love of justice & dedication to service.

How will this position help you to reach your vision and mission goals:

We would like a pastor who brings joy and enthusiasm to the congregation while sharing God's love with others; a pastor who will walk beside us as we work to grow our congregation, and help us be a church that reaches out in a consistent manner. - Provide pastoral thoughts for monthly newsletter.
