Position:

Bridge Pastor

Purpose:

Prior to calling an Interim Pastor, the Bridge Pastor will provide spiritual leadership, pastoral care with a program of worship, teaching, and fellowship.

Accountability:

To the session and the presbytery.

Responsibilities:

1. Provide a faith filled, Bible based worship service each Sunday with the help of staff. Perform memorial services and weddings as needed.
2. Serve as Moderator of Session and provide guidance and training to Session, Deacons, Ministry teams, Stewardship, enabling and equipping them to serve the congregation.
3. Oversee and support the existing staff, listening to their ideas and learning from their experience.
4. In conjunction with the Deacons, visit the ill and homebound with Christ's compassion, bringing comfort and hope.

Relationships:

Relates to the staff as head of staff, the session as moderator, the members as pastor, teams and committees as ex-officio member and servant leader, and the presbytery as a continuing member.

Evaluation:

Performance review will be conducted by the Personnel Team.

Compensation:

Offering a one half to three quarter time position following the compensation guidelines of Presbytery. Terms to be negotiable.
