- During this brief interval, we expect pastoral care to be handled primarily by the Deacons and members of the congregation, but the Bridge Pastor may also need to provide care upon occasion
- Lead memorial services if needed during the interval

- Collaborate with church staff and volunteers to ensure smooth operations
- Moderate the annual congregational meeting and any special meetings
