Pastoral Care

- Visit and provide pastoral care for those who are homebound, hospitalized, or experiencing crisis.

- Moderate Session meetings, helping the congregation discern God's direction for its ministry.
- Encourage thoughtful stewardship while helping the congregation remain financially healthy and mission-focused.
- Serve as Head of Staff.

- Support and encourage the church's Saturday Food Program and its ongoing outreach to the community.
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About Community Presbyterian Church

Community Presbyterian Church has faithfully served Waldport since **1900**. Our current sanctuary was dedicated on **March 16, 1958**, and seats approximately 250 people.

Today our congregation includes **26 members**, with an average Sunday attendance of **27 in person** and **6 participating via Zoom**.

One of our signature ministries is our **Saturday Food Program**. In 2013–2014, former Sunday School classrooms were transformed into a commercial kitchen to support this outreach. Each week the program provides a hot meal and nutritious food boxes to more than **100 individuals** in our community.

About the Waldport Area and Community

Nestled along Oregon's spectacular central coast, **Waldport** offers an exceptional quality of life for those who appreciate natural beauty, a close-knit community, and a slower pace of living. Situated where the Alsea River meets the Pacific Ocean, the town is surrounded by sandy beaches, forests, hiking trails, kayaking, fishing, and breathtaking coastal scenery.
